Amend SS/HCS#2/House Bill Nos. 567, et al, Page 1, Section A, Line 6,

2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "290.502. 1. Except as may be otherwise provided
4 pursuant to sections 290.500 to 290.530, effective January
5 1, 2007, every employer shall pay to each employee wages at
6 the rate of \$6.50 per hour, or wages at the same rate or
7 rates set under the provisions of federal law as the
8 prevailing federal minimum wage applicable to those covered
9 jobs in interstate commerce, whichever rate per hour is
10 higher.

11 2. The minimum wage shall be increased or decreased on
12 January 1, 2008, and on January 1 of successive years, by
13 the increase or decrease in the cost of living. On
14 September 30, 2007, and on each September 30 of each
15 successive year, the director shall measure the increase or
16 decrease in the cost of living by the percentage increase or
17 decrease as of the preceding July over the level as of July
18 of the immediately preceding year of the Consumer Price
19 Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W) or
20 successor index as published by the U.S. Department of Labor
21 or its successor agency, with the amount of the minimum wage
22 increase or decrease rounded to the nearest five cents.

23 3. Except as may be otherwise provided pursuant to
24 sections 290.500 to 290.530, and notwithstanding subsection
25 1 of this section, effective January 1, 2025, every employer
26 shall pay to each employee wages at the rate of not less

27 than \$13.75 per hour, or wages at the same rate or rates set
28 under the provisions of federal law as the prevailing
29 federal minimum wage applicable to those covered jobs in
30 interstate commerce, whichever rate per hour is higher.

31 Thereafter, the minimum wage established by this subsection
32 shall be increased [by \$1.25 per hour, to \$15.00] to
33 seventeen dollars per hour, effective January 1, 2026.

34 Thereafter, the minimum wage established by this subsection
35 shall be increased or decreased on January 1, 2027, and on
36 January 1 of successive years, per the method set forth in
37 subsection 2 of this section. If at any time the federal
38 minimum wage rate is above or is thereafter increased above
39 the minimum wage then in effect under this subsection, the
40 minimum wage required by this subsection shall continue to
41 be increased pursuant to this subsection, but the higher
42 federal rate shall immediately become the minimum wage
43 required by this subsection and shall be increased or
44 decreased per the method set forth in subsection 2 for so
45 long as it remains higher than the state minimum wage
46 required and increased pursuant to this subsection.

47 4. For purposes of this section, the term "public
48 employer" means an employer that is the state or a political
49 subdivision of the state, including a department, agency,
50 officer, bureau, division, board, commission, or
51 instrumentality of the state, or a city, county, town,
52 village, school district, or other political subdivision of
53 the state. Subsection 3 of this section shall not apply to
54 a public employer with respect to its employees. Any public
55 employer that is subject to subsections 1 and 2 of this
56 section shall continue to be subject to those subsections."
