Amend SS/SCS/HCS/House Bill No. 711, Page 40, Section 161.670, Line 551,

by inserting after all of said line the following: 2 3 "162.481. 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section and sections 162.492 and 162.563, all elections of 4 school directors in urban school districts shall be held 5 biennially at the same times and places as municipal 6 7 elections. 8 2. Except as otherwise provided in subsections 3, 4, [and] 5, and 7 of this section, hereafter when a seven-9 director district becomes an urban school district, the 10 directors of the prior seven-director district shall 11 continue as directors of the urban school district until the 12 expiration of the terms for which they were elected and 13 until their successors are elected as provided in this 14 15 subsection. The first biennial school election for 16 directors shall be held in the urban school district at the time provided in subsection 1 which is on the date of or 17 subsequent to the expiration of the terms of the directors 18 of the prior district which are first to expire, and 19 directors shall be elected to succeed the directors of the 20 21 prior district whose terms have expired. If the terms of two directors only have expired, the directors elected at 22 23 the first biennial school election in the urban school 24 district shall be elected for terms of six years. If the terms of four directors have expired, two directors shall be 25 elected for terms of six years and two shall be elected for 26

- 27 terms of four years. At the next succeeding biennial
- 28 election held in the urban school district, successors for
- 29 the remaining directors of the prior seven-director district
- 30 shall be elected. If only two directors are to be elected
- 31 they shall be elected for terms of six years each. If four
- 32 directors are to be elected, two shall be elected for terms
- 33 of six years and two shall be elected for terms of two
- 34 years. After seven directors of the urban school district
- 35 have been elected under this subsection, their successors
- 36 shall be elected for terms of six years.
- 37 3. In any school district in which a majority of the
- 38 district is located in any home rule city with more than one
- 39 hundred fifty-five thousand but fewer than two hundred
- 40 thousand inhabitants, elections shall be held annually at
- 41 the same times and places as general municipal elections for
- 42 all years where one or more terms expire, and the terms
- 43 shall be for three years and until their successors are duly
- 44 elected and qualified for all directors elected on and after
- 45 August 28, 1998.
- 4. For any school district which becomes an urban
- 47 school district by reason of the 2000 federal decennial
- 48 census, elections shall be held annually at the same times
- 49 and places as general municipal elections for all years
- 50 where one or more terms expire, and the terms shall be for
- 51 three years and until their successors are duly elected and
- 52 qualified for all directors elected on and after August 28,
- 53 2001.
- 5. In any school district in any county with a charter
- 55 form of government and with more than three hundred thousand
- 56 but fewer than four hundred fifty thousand inhabitants which
- 57 becomes an urban school district by reason of the 2010
- 58 federal decennial census, elections shall be held annually
- 59 at the same times and places as general municipal elections

- for all years where one or more terms expire, and the terms
 shall be for three years and until their successors are duly
 elected and qualified for all directors elected on and after
 April 2, 2012.
- In any urban school district in a county of the 64 65 first classification with more than eighty-three thousand 66 but fewer than ninety-two thousand inhabitants and with a 67 home rule city with more than seventy-six thousand but fewer than ninety-one thousand inhabitants as the county seat, 68 69 elections shall be held annually at the same times and places as general municipal elections for all years where 70 one or more terms expire, and upon expiration of any term 71 after August 28, 2015, the term of office shall be for three 72 73 years and until their successors are duly elected and 74 qualified.
- 75 7. In any school district in which a majority of the 76 district is located in a city with more than one hundred 77 five thousand but fewer than one hundred twenty-five 78 thousand inhabitants, elections shall be held annually at 79 the same times and places as general municipal elections for all years where one or more terms expire, and upon the 80 expiration of any term after August 28, 2025, the term of 81 office shall be for three years and until their successors 82 83 are duly elected and qualified."; and 84

"3. Any school district, located within a city not within a county or wholly or partially located within a county with more than one million inhabitants, with a preceding year board-approved school calendar that provided for one hundred sixty-nine school days or more of planned attendance shall be exempt from the requirement to set an opening date each year no earlier than fourteen calendar

93 days prior to the first Monday in September pursuant to subsection 2 of section 171.031."; and 94 Further amend said bill, page 106, section 170.315, 95 line 80, by inserting after all of said line the following: 96 "171.027. Any provision of state law that requires a 97 98 school district to conduct an election of the voters of the school district in order to adopt a four-day school week 99 shall not apply to any school district that had a four-day 100 school week in the 2023-24 school year [and] or that 101 102 contains all of a city with more than two thousand one hundred fifty but fewer than two thousand four hundred 103 inhabitants and is located in a county with more than 104 nineteen thousand but fewer than twenty-two thousand 105 inhabitants and with a county seat with more than two 106 107 thousand two hundred twenty but fewer than two thousand five hundred inhabitants."; and 108 109 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
