ANACT

To amend chapter 324, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the issuance of professional licenses to certain individuals.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 324, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 324.1173, to read as
- 3 follows:
 - 324.1173. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 2 law to the contrary, for purposes of obtaining a
- 3 professional or occupational license, a person has
- 4 demonstrated lawful presence and is eligible to obtain a
- 5 professional or occupational license if the person submits:
- 6 (1) An unexpired employment authorization document
- 7 issued by the United States Department of Homeland Security,
- 8 Form I-766; and
- 9 (2) Documentation issued by the United States
- 10 Department of Homeland Security, the United States
- 11 Citizenship and Immigration Services, or any other federal
- 12 agency, including a Form I-797 used by the United States
- 13 Citizenship and Immigration Services, demonstrating that
- 14 such person is described in Section 202(c)(2)(B)(i) through
- 15 (ix) of the federal REAL ID Act of 2005, Pub. L. 109-13.
- 16 2. A professional or occupational license issued to a
- 17 person eligible pursuant to subsection 1 of this section

18 shall be valid only for the period of time during which such

- 19 person's employment authorization document is valid.
- 3. Nothing in this section shall affect the
- 21 requirements to obtain a professional or occupational
- 22 license that are unrelated to the lawful presence
- 23 requirements demonstrated pursuant to this section.
- 4. Nothing in this section shall be construed to grant
- 25 eligibility for any public benefits other than obtaining a
- 26 professional or occupational license.
- 27 5. Any person who has complied with the requirements
- 28 of this section shall have his or her employment
- 29 authorization document verified through the Systematic Alien
- 30 Verification for Entitlements Program operated by the United
- 31 States Department of Homeland Security or an equivalent
- 32 program designated by the United States Department of
- 33 Homeland Security.
- 34 6. The general assembly enacts this section pursuant
- 35 to the authority provided in 8 U.S.C. Section 1621(d), as
- 36 such section existed on August 28, 2026.
