AN ACT

To repeal section 575.353, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the offense of assault on a law enforcement animal, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 575.353, RSMo, is repealed and one new

- 2 section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 575.353,
- 3 to read as follows:
 - 575.353. 1. This section shall be known and may be
- 2 cited as "Max's Law".
- 3 2. A person commits the offense of assault on a law
- 4 enforcement animal if he or she knowingly attempts to kill
- 5 or disable or knowingly causes or attempts to cause serious
- 6 physical injury to a law enforcement animal when that animal
- 7 is involved in law enforcement investigation, apprehension,
- 8 tracking, or search, or the animal is in the custody of or
- 9 under the control of a law enforcement officer, department
- 10 of corrections officer, municipal police department, fire
- 11 department or a rescue unit or agency.
- 12 3. The offense of assault on a law enforcement animal
- 13 is a:
- 14 (1) Class [A misdemeanor] E felony, if the law
- 15 enforcement animal is not injured to the point of requiring
- 16 veterinary care or treatment;

17 (2) Class [E] **D** felony if the law enforcement animal 18 is seriously injured to the point of requiring veterinary 19 care or treatment; and

20 (3) Class [D] C felony if the assault results in the 21 death of such animal.
