AN ACT

To amend chapters 311 and 313, RSMo, by adding thereto three new sections relating to background checks for certain license applications.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapters 311 and 313, RSMo, are amended by

- 2 adding thereto three new sections, to be known as sections
- 3 311.661, 313.912, and 313.1000, to read as follows:
 - 311.661. 1. As used in this section, the following
- 2 terms shall mean:
- 3 (1) "Alcohol carrier or transportation license", a
- 4 license issued to an applicant for the transport or delivery
- 5 of intoxicating liquor into, within, or through this state;
- 6 (2) "Manufacturer-solicitor, domestic winery, or
- 7 microbrewery liquor license", a license issued to an
- 8 applicant authorizing the manufacturing, distilling,
- 9 blending, or brewing of intoxicating liquor in this state;
- 10 (3) "Owner", an individual holding ten percent or
- 11 greater financial interest or voting interest in an entity
- 12 seeking to be licensed;
- 13 (4) "Primary retail liquor license", a license issued
- 14 to an applicant for the retail sale of intoxicating liquor
- 15 in this state;
- 16 (5) "Solicitor license", a license issued to an
- 17 applicant that allows for the solicitation of orders for the

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sale of intoxicating liquor to wholesalers licensed in this state;

- 20 (6) "Wholesalers license", a license issued to an
- 21 applicant authorizing the sale of intoxicating liquor to
- 22 retail licensees;
- 23 (7) "Wine direct shipper license", a license issued to
- 24 an applicant allowing for the direct shipping of
- 25 intoxicating liquor to consumers who are residents of this
- 26 state and who are at least twenty-one years of age for their
- 27 personal use and not for resale.
- 28 2. The division of alcohol and tobacco control may
- 29 require any owner or applicant, as such term is defined in
- 30 section 43.540, seeking a license for the manufacture, sale,
- 31 transport, consumption, or delivery of intoxicating liquors
- 32 within this state, as provided in this chapter, to submit
- 33 fingerprints to the Missouri state highway patrol for the
- 34 purpose of conducting a state and federal fingerprint-based
- 35 criminal history background check. Such background check
- 36 shall be required for the following licenses:
- 37 (1) Alcohol carrier or transportation license;
- 38 (2) Manufacturer-solicitor, domestic winery, or
- 39 microbrewery liquor license;
- 40 (3) Primary retail liquor license;
- 41 (4) Solicitor license;
- 42 (5) Wholesalers license; and
- 43 (6) Wine direct shipper license.
- 44 3. The fingerprints and any required fees shall be
- 45 sent to the Missouri state highway patrol's central
- 46 repository. The fingerprints shall be used for searching
- 47 the state criminal records repository and shall also be
- 48 forwarded to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for a
- 49 federal criminal records search under section 43.540. The

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50 Missouri state highway patrol shall notify the division of

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- 51 alcohol and tobacco control of any criminal history record
- 52 information or lack of criminal history record information
- 53 discovered on the individual. Notwithstanding the
- 54 provisions of section 610.120 to the contrary, all records
- 55 related to any criminal history information discovered shall
- 56 be accessible and available to the division of alcohol and
- 57 tobacco control.
 - 313.912. 1. As used in this section, the following
- 2 terms shall mean:
- 3 (1) "Officer", the president, vice president,
- 4 treasurer, secretary, and other officers identified in an
- 5 entity's bylaws or incorporation documents, a member or
- 6 manager of a limited liability company, a sole proprietor,
- 7 or a partner;
- 8 (2) "Principal salaried executive staff officers", the
- 9 president, any vice president in charge of a principal
- 10 business unit, division, or function, such as sales,
- 11 administration, or finance, any other officer who performs a
- 12 policy-making function, or any other person who performs
- 13 similar policy-making functions for a fantasy sports contest
- 14 operator. Executive officers of subsidiaries may be deemed
- 15 principal salaried executive staff officers of the fantasy
- 16 sports contest operator if they perform such policy-making
- 17 functions for the fantasy sports contest operator.
- 18 2. The commission may require that fingerprint
- 19 submissions be made as part of an application for a fantasy
- 20 sports contest operator license by any employees, officers,
- 21 directors, and principal salaried executive staff officers
- 22 of a fantasy sports contest operator to conduct fantasy
- 23 sports contest activities.

If the commission requires that fingerprint submissions be made as part of such application, the commission shall require applicants to submit fingerprints to the Missouri state highway patrol for the purpose of conducting a state and federal fingerprint-based criminal
- 30 The fingerprints and any required fees shall be 31 sent to the Missouri state highway patrol's central 32 repository. The fingerprints shall be used for searching 33 the state criminal records repository and shall also be 34 forwarded to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for a federal criminal records search under section 43.540. The 35 Missouri state highway patrol shall notify the commission of 36 37 any criminal history record information or lack of criminal 38 history record information discovered on the individual. 39 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 610.120 to the 40 contrary, all records related to any criminal history 41 information discovered shall be accessible and available to 42 the commission.
- 313.1000. 1. As used in this section, all terms shall have the same meaning as defined in Article III, Section 39(g) of the Missouri Constitution.
- 2. The commission may require that fingerprint submissions be made as part of an application for a retail license or mobile license.
- 3. If the commission requires that fingerprint submissions be made as part of such application, the commission shall require applicants to submit fingerprints to the Missouri state highway patrol for the purpose of conducting a state and federal fingerprint-based criminal history background check.
