## AN ACT

To amend chapter 407, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the sale of wood products.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 407, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 407.3300, to read as follows:

**407.3300. 1. No person, company, or business shall sell or market products using the term wood without the product's decorative surface being made of solid wood or wood veneer, originating from a tree. No person, company, or business shall advertise or sell any part of a product marketed using wood-related terms or names of wood species including, but not limited to, oak, maple, cherry, pine, and walnut if the product's decorative surface is not that wood species.**

**2. A person, company, or business may sell any product physically located within the state as of August 28, 2026, that is packaged in violation of the provisions of subsection 1 of this section if the product is clearly labeled: "This product is not made from wood.". After August 28, 2026, no additional products shall enter the state if the packaging is in violation of subsection 1 of this section.**

18           3. The department of agriculture may promulgate all  
19 necessary rules and regulations for the administration of  
20 this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term  
21 is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the  
22 authority delegated in this section shall become effective  
23 only if it complies with and is subject to all of the  
24 provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section  
25 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and  
26 if any of the powers vested with the general assembly  
27 pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective  
28 date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently  
29 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking  
30 authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28,  
31 2026, shall be invalid and void.
