## AN ACT

To amend chapter 21, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to limitations on the number of bills introduced by members of the general assembly.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 21, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto  
2 one new section, to be known as section 21.1080, to read as  
3 follows:

21.1080. 1. No member of the house of representatives  
2 shall be permitted to introduce more than five legislative  
3 bills or joint resolutions during a regular session of the  
4 general assembly.

5 2. No member of the senate shall be permitted to  
6 introduce more than ten legislative bills or joint  
7 resolutions during a regular session of the general assembly.

8 3. The provisions of this section may be waived by a  
9 house of the general assembly to permit a member to  
10 introduce a bill or joint resolution in excess of the limits  
11 provided in subsections 1 and 2 of this section only upon  
12 approval of such waiver by at least two-thirds of the  
13 elected members of the house.

14 3. The provisions of this section shall not apply to  
15 the introduction of an appropriation bill.
