## **AN ACT**

To repeal sections 313.205 and 313.230, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to the state lottery.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

- Section A. Sections 313.205 and 313.230, RSMo, are
- 2 repealed and two new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be
- 3 known as sections 313.205 and 313.230, to read as follows:
  - 313.205. As used in sections 313.200 to 313.350, the
- 2 following words and terms shall have the meanings ascribed
- 3 to them in this section unless the context clearly requires
- 4 otherwise:
- 5 (1) "Commission" or "lottery commission", the three-
- 6 member body appointed by the governor to manage and oversee
- 7 the lottery and to appoint a director;
- 8 (2) "Commissioner", one of the members of the lottery
- 9 commission appointed by the governor pursuant to the
- 10 provisions of sections 313.200 to 313.350;
- 11 (3) "Director", the director of the state lottery
- 12 appointed by the commission as the chief administrator of
- 13 the state lottery;
- 14 (4) "Division", the division of the state lottery
- 15 authorized by sections 313.200 to 313.350;

EXPLANATION-Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

- 16 (5) "Lottery" or "state lottery", the state lottery
  17 established and operated pursuant to the provisions of
  18 sections 313.200 to 313.350;
- 19 (6) "Lottery contractor" or "lottery vendor", a person
  20 with whom the division has contracted to provide goods or
  21 services for the state lottery;
- 22 (7) "Lottery game" or "game", any procedure authorized 23 by written rule of the commission or by law whereby prizes 24 are distributed among persons who have paid, or have 25 unconditionally agreed to pay, for tickets or shares in 26 either a physical or electronic format which provide the 27 opportunity to win such prizes;
- 28 (8) "Lottery game retailer", any person with whom the 29 lottery commission has contracted to sell tickets or shares 30 in lottery games to the public;
- 31 (9) "Lottery ticket" or "shares", any bearer 32 instrument in a physical form or in an electronic format 33 authorized by the commission. A bearer instrument may 34 include credits that can be redeemed for use in playing 35 future lottery games;
- (10) "Person", any natural person, firm, corporation,
  or other legal entity possessing a department of revenue
  retail sales license, as provided by law.

#### 313.230. The commission shall:

- 2 (1) Issue rules and regulations concerning the 3 operation of the Missouri state lottery. The rules and 4 regulations shall include, but shall not be limited to, the 5 following:
- 6 (a) The type of lottery to be conducted, except no
  7 lottery may use any coin- or token-operated amusement device
  8 [and no]. Lottery [game shall] games may be based [in any
- 9 form] on the outcome of sporting events where the maximum

- 10 ticket price does not exceed five dollars per ticket.
- 11 [However,] It shall be legal to use clerk- or player-
- 12 activated terminals or kiosks[, which are coin- or currency-
- operated, 1 to [dispense] sell lottery tickets. The
- 14 commission may also use an internet application to sell
- 15 electronic scratcher games, draw games, and pull-tab games
- 16 where a player may access such internet application to buy
- 17 lottery tickets in an electronic format using a personal
- 18 device;
- 19 (b) The price, or prices, of tickets or shares in the
- 20 lottery;
- 21 (c) The numbers and sizes of the prizes on the winning
- 22 tickets or shares;
- 23 (d) The manner of selecting the winning tickets or
- 24 shares;
- 25 (e) The manner of payment of prizes to the holders of
- 26 winning tickets or shares;
- 27 (f) The frequency of the drawings or selections of
- 28 winning tickets or shares, without limitation;
- 29 (g) The types or numbers of locations at which tickets
- 30 or shares may be sold and the method to be used in selling
- 31 tickets or shares;
- 32 (h) The method to be used in selling tickets or shares;
- (i) The licensing of lottery game retailers to sell
- 34 tickets or shares;
- 35 (j) The manner and amount of compensation, including
- 36 commissions, ticket discounts, incentives and any other
- 37 remuneration, to be paid to or retained by lottery game
- 38 retailers;
- 39 (k) The apportionment of the total revenues accruing
- 40 from the sale of lottery tickets or shares and from all
- 41 other sources among:

42 a. The payment of prizes to the holders of winning 43 tickets or shares;

- b. The payment of costs incurred in the operation and administration of the lottery, including the expenses of the commission and the costs resulting from any contract or contracts entered into for promotional, advertising or operational services or for the purchase or lease of lottery equipment and materials;
- 50 c. For the repayment to the general revenue fund of
  51 any amount appropriated for initial start-up of the lottery;
  52 and
- d. For timely transfer to the state lottery fund asprovided by law;
  - (1) Such other matters necessary or desirable for the efficient and economical operation and administration of the lottery and for the convenience of the purchasers of tickets or shares and the holders of winning tickets or shares. The commission may disburse money for payment of lottery prizes;
- 60 (2) Amend, repeal, or supplement any such rules and 61 regulations from time to time as it deems necessary or 62 desirable:
  - (3) Advise and make recommendations to the director regarding the operation and administration of the lottery;
  - (4) Report quarterly to the governor and the general assembly the total lottery revenues, prize disbursements and other expenses for the preceding quarter, and to make an annual report, which shall include a full and complete statement of lottery revenues, prize disbursements and other expenses, to the governor and the general assembly, and including such recommendations for changes in sections 313.200 to 313.350 as it deems necessary or desirable;

73 (5) Report to the governor and general assembly any
74 matters which shall require immediate changes in the laws of
75 this state in order to prevent abuses and evasions of
76 sections 313.200 to 313.350 or rules and regulations
77 promulgated thereunder or to rectify undesirable conditions
78 in connection with the administration or operation of the
79 lottery;

- (6) Carry on a continuous study and investigation of the lottery throughout the state and to make a continuous study and investigation of the operation and the administration of similar laws which may be in effect in other states or countries, any literature on the subject which from time to time may be published or available, any federal laws which may affect the operation of the lottery, and the reaction of Missouri citizens to existing and potential features of the lottery with a view to recommending or effecting changes that will tend to serve the purposes of sections 313.200 to 313.350;
- (7) Ensure that all employees of the state lottery commission hired after July 12, 1990, shall not be related to any member of the state lottery commission or any employee of the state lottery commission within the third degree of consanguinity or affinity.
