AN ACT

To repeal section 41.430, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the National Guard.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 41.430, RSMo, is repealed and one new

- 2 section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 41.430,
- 3 to read as follows:
 - 41.430. 1. This section shall be known and may be
- 2 cited as "The Supporting Missouri Servicemen and Women Act".
- 3 2. Officers, warrant officers and enlisted personnel
- 4 of the organized militia on active duty in the service of
- 5 the state shall receive as compensation the same pay,
- 6 longevity, and allowances as are or may be provided for
- 7 members of like grade and branch of service in the Armed
- 8 Forces of the United States[.], except:
- 9 (1) Members of the organized militia serving on active
- 10 duty shall receive as a minimum the daily rate equivalent to
- 11 the grade level of E5 with maximum longevity and with
- 12 dependents;
- 13 (2) If the active duty is less than thirty days, the
- 14 pay shall be the same as members of like grade and branch of
- 15 service in the Armed Forces of the United States on active
- 16 duty for more than thirty days; and
