## AN ACT

To amend chapter 407, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the sale of wood products.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 407, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto  
2 one new section, to be known as section 407.3300, to read as  
3 follows:

**407.3300. 1. No person, company, or business shall**  
2 **sell or market products in a manner that is false or**  
3 **misleading by using the term "wood" to describe the material**  
4 **composition of a product or component without the product's**  
5 **decorative surface being made of solid wood or wood veneer,**  
6 **originating from a tree. No person, company, or business**  
7 **shall advertise or sell in a manner that is false or**  
8 **misleading any part of a product marketed as wood using wood-**  
9 **related terms or names of wood species including, but not**  
10 **limited to, oak, maple, cherry, pine, and walnut if the**  
11 **product's decorative surface is not that wood species.**

12 **2. A person, company, or business may sell any product**  
13 **physically located within the state as of August 28, 2026,**  
14 **that is packaged in violation of the provisions of**  
15 **subsection 1 of this section if the product is clearly**  
16 **labeled: "This product is not made from wood.". After**

17 August 28, 2026, no additional products shall enter the  
18 state if the packaging is in violation of subsection 1 of  
19 this section.

20 3. The department of agriculture may promulgate all  
21 necessary rules and regulations for the administration of  
22 this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term  
23 is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the  
24 authority delegated in this section shall become effective  
25 only if it complies with and is subject to all of the  
26 provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section  
27 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and  
28 if any of the powers vested with the general assembly  
29 pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective  
30 date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently  
31 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking  
32 authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28,  
33 2026, shall be invalid and void.

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
