AN ACT

To repeal section 79.070, RSMo 1994, relating to fourth class cities, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the same subject.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 79.070, RSMo 1994, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 79.070, to read as follows:

79.070. No person shall be an alderman unless he be at least twenty-one years of age, a citizen of the United States, and an inhabitant and resident of the city for one year next preceding his election, and a resident **at the time he files and during the time he serves** of the ward from which he is elected.

EXPLANATION--Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
