## AN ACT

Relating to the administrative hearing commission by adding thereto one new section relating to the same subject.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

**Section 1. In all proceedings before the administrative hearing commission or any state agency it shall not be necessary for a corporation authorized to do business in this state to be represented by counsel if such corporation is represented by either the president or chief executive officer of such corporation or a person employed by such corporation and designated by the president or chief executive officer to represent the corporation. In any such proceeding before the administrative hearing commission or a state agency whereby a corporation is represented by either its president or chief executive officer, or by a designated person, such representation shall not be construed to be the practice of law as such term is defined in section 484.010, RSMo.**
