AN ACT

To repeal section 186.060, RSMo Supp. 1998, relating to the Missouri humanities council, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the same subject.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 186.060, RSMo Supp. 1998, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 186.060, to read as follows:

186.060. Subject to appropriation from general revenue, one million dollars may be appropriated to the Missouri humanities council. [Up to fifty percent of the] Grants made to the Missouri humanities council may be used for operating and programming expenses and the remaining funds shall be transferred to the Missouri humanities council trust fund established in section 186.055 except the administrative costs shall not exceed five percent of such funding.

EXPLANATION--Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
