AN ACT

To repeal section 33.170, RSMo 1994, relating to state funds for designated public purposes, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the same subject.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 33.170, RSMo 1994, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 33.170, to read as follows:

33.170. **1.** No claim or account shall be preapproved by the commissioner of administration, nor shall any warrant be paid by the state treasurer, unless the money has been previously appropriated by law; nor shall the whole amount drawn for or paid, under any one head, ever exceed the amount appropriated by law for that purpose.

2. The general assembly may appropriate funds to departments as grant moneys to advance any specifically designated public purpose. The commissioner of administration may approve warrants requested in accordance with the terms of such appropriations.

AN ACT
