AN ACT

To repeal section 48.053, RSMo 1994, relating to elections of certain county treasurers, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the same subject.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 48.053, RSMo 1994, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 48.053, to read as follows:

48.053. The incumbent of the office of county treasurer of a county changing from third [class] classification to second [class] or first classification or from second [class] classification to third [class] classification shall continue to hold office for the term to which he or she was elected. [His] The successor in office shall be elected at the general election next preceding the expiration of the incumbent's term of office to a term of two years and until [his] a successor is elected, as provided in section 54.010, RSMo, and qualified.
