Amend Senate Bill No. 373, Page 1, Section title, Lines 2-3,

2 by striking the words "the Missouri senior farmers' market
3 nutrition program" and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
4 "seniors"; and

5 Further amend said bill and page, section A, line 2, by
6 inserting after all of said line the following:

7 "192.385. 1. There is hereby established in the department
8 of health and senior services the "Senior Services Growth and
9 Development Program" to provide additional funding for senior
10 services provided through the area agencies on aging in this
11 state.

12 2. Beginning January 1, 2018, two and one-half percent, and
13 begining January 1, 2019, and each year thereafter, five percent
14 of the premium tax collected under sections 148.320 and 148.370,
15 excluding any moneys to be transferred to the state school moneys
16 fund as described in section 148.360, shall be deposited in the
17 fund created in subsection 3 of this section.

18 3. (1) There is hereby created in the state treasury the
19 "Senior Services Growth and Development Program Fund", which
20 shall consist of moneys collected under this section. The
21 director of the department of revenue shall collect the moneys

1 described in subsection 2 of this section and shall remit such
2 moneys to the state treasurer for deposit in the fund, less one
3 percent for the cost of collection. In accordance with sections
4 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer may approve disbursements.
5 The fund shall be a dedicated fund and moneys in the fund shall
6 be used solely by the department of health and senior services
7 for enhancing senior services provided by area agencies on aging
8 in this state.

9 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 to the
10 contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the
11 biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue
12 fund. This fund is not intended to supplant general revenue
13 provided for senior services.

14 (3) The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in
15 the same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and
16 moneys earned on such investments shall be credited to the fund.

17 4. The department of health and senior services shall
18 disburse the moneys from the fund to the area agencies on aging
19 in accordance with the funding formula used by the department to
20 disburse other federal and state moneys to the area agencies on
21 aging.

22 5. At least fifty percent of all moneys distributed under
23 this section shall be applied by area agencies on aging to the
24 development and expansion of senior center programs, facilities,
25 and services.

26 6. All area agencies on aging shall report, either
27 individually or as an association, annually to the department of
28 health and senior services, the department of insurance,
29 financial institutions, and professional registration, and the

1 general assembly on the distribution and use of moneys under this
2 section. The board of directors and the advisory board of each
3 area agency on aging shall be responsible for ensuring the proper
4 use and distribution of such moneys.

5 7. The department of health and senior services may
6 promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.
7 Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section
8 536.010 that is created under the authority delegated in this
9 section shall become effective only if it complies with and is
10 subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536, and, if
11 applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are
12 nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general
13 assembly pursuant to chapter 536, to review, to delay the
14 effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are
15 subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking
16 authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2017,
17 shall be invalid and void."; and

18 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
