Amend SS/Senate Bill No. 1233, Page 1, Section TITLE, Line 5,

2 by striking the word "accountants" and inserting in lieu  
3 thereof the following: "certain professionals"; and

4 Further amend said bill, page 29, section 326.292, line  
5 228, by inserting after all of said line the following:

6 "345.050. To be eligible for licensure by the board by  
7 examination, each applicant shall submit the application fee  
8 and shall furnish evidence of such person's current  
9 competence and shall:

10 (1) Hold a master's or a doctoral degree from a  
11 program that was awarded "accreditation candidate" status or  
12 is accredited by the Council on Academic Accreditation of  
13 the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association or other  
14 accrediting agency approved by the board in the area in  
15 which licensure is sought;

16 (2) Submit official transcripts from one or more  
17 accredited colleges or universities presenting evidence of  
18 the completion of course work and clinical practicum  
19 requirements equivalent to that required by the Council on  
20 Academic Accreditation of the American Speech-Language-  
21 Hearing Association or other accrediting agency approved by  
22 the board;

23 (3) Present written evidence of completion of a  
24 clinical fellowship from supervisors. The experience  
25 required by this subdivision shall follow the completion of

26 the requirements of subdivisions (1) and (2) of this  
27 section. This period of employment shall be under the  
28 direct supervision of a [person who is licensed by the state  
29 of Missouri in the profession in which the applicant seeks  
30 to be] licensed speech-language pathologist in good  
31 standing. Persons applying with an audiology clinical  
32 doctoral degree are exempt from this provision; and

33 (4) Pass an examination promulgated or approved by the  
34 board. The board shall determine the subject and scope of  
35 the examinations."; and

36 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
