Amend SS/SCS/Senate Bill Nos. 984 & 968, Page 1, Section TITLE, Line 4,

2 by striking "managers"; and

3 Further amend said bill, page 14, section 376.399, line
4 5, by inserting after all of said line the following:

5 "376.1240. 1. For purposes of this section, terms
6 shall have the same meanings as ascribed to them in section
7 376.1350, and the term "self-administered hormonal
8 contraceptive" shall mean a drug that is composed of one or
9 more hormones and that is approved by the Food and Drug
10 Administration to prevent pregnancy, excluding emergency
11 contraception. Nothing in this section shall be construed
12 to apply to medications approved by the Food and Drug
13 Administration to terminate an existing pregnancy.

14 2. (1) Any health benefit plan delivered, issued for
15 delivery, continued, or renewed in this state on or after
16 January 1, 2026, that provides coverage for self-
17 administered hormonal contraceptives shall provide coverage
18 to reimburse a health care provider or dispensing entity for
19 the dispensing of a supply of self-administered hormonal
20 contraceptives intended to last up to ninety days, or
21 intended to last up to one hundred eighty days for generic
22 self-administered hormonal contraceptives. The provisions
23 of this subdivision shall no longer be in effect after
24 December 31, 2026.

25 (2) Any health benefit plan delivered, issued for
26 delivery, continued, or renewed in this state on or after
27 January 1, 2027, that provides coverage for self-
28 administered hormonal contraceptives shall provide coverage
29 to reimburse a health care provider or dispensing entity for
30 the dispensing of a supply of self-administered hormonal
31 contraceptives, including generic and brand-name
32 contraceptives, intended to last up to one year.

33 3. The coverage required under this section shall not
34 be subject to any greater deductible or co-payment than
35 other similar health care services provided by the health
36 benefit plan.

37 376.1960. 1. As used in this section, the following
38 terms mean:

39 (1) "Health benefit plan", the same meaning given to
40 the term in section 376.1350;

41 (2) "Home blood pressure monitoring device", a mobile
42 device that can be used to measure blood pressure, and that
43 is validated for clinical accuracy and device calibration;

44 (3) "Home blood pressure monitoring device services",
45 patient education and training services on the setup and use
46 of a home blood pressure monitoring device, separate self-
47 measurement blood pressure readings, daily collection and
48 transmission of data reports by the patient or caregiver to
49 the health care provider in order to communicate blood
50 pressure readings, review of the reports by the health care
51 provider, and creation or modification of treatment plans
52 based on the reports.

53 2. Health benefit plans delivered, issued for
54 delivery, continued or renewed in this state on or after
55 January 1, 2026, and providing for maternity benefits, shall
56 provide coverage for a home blood pressure monitoring device

57 and home blood pressure monitoring device services for
58 pregnant and postpartum women."; and
59 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
