Amend SS/HCS/HB Bill Nos. 1664, et al., Page 1, Section 516.120, Line \_\_\_\_\_,

2 by striking all of said section from the bill; and

3 Further amend said bill, page 2, section 516.130, by  
4 striking all of said section from the bill; and

5 Further amend said bill, pages 2-3, section 537.046, by  
6 striking all of said section and inserting in lieu thereof  
7 the following:

8 "537.046. 1. As used in this section, the following  
9 terms mean:

10 (1) "Childhood sexual abuse", any act committed by the  
11 defendant against the plaintiff which act occurred when the  
12 plaintiff was under the age of eighteen years and which act  
13 would have been a violation of section 566.030, 566.031,  
14 566.032, 566.034, 566.060, 566.061, 566.062, 566.064,  
15 566.067, 566.068, 566.069, 566.071, 566.083, 566.086,  
16 566.093, 566.095, 566.100, 566.101, 566.209, 566.210,  
17 566.211, 568.020, 573.023, or 573.200;

18 (2) "Injury" or "illness", either a physical injury or  
19 illness or a psychological injury or illness. A  
20 psychological injury or illness need not be accompanied by  
21 physical injury or illness.

22 2. Any action to recover damages from injury or  
23 illness caused by childhood sexual abuse in an action  
24 brought pursuant to this section shall be commenced within  
25 [ten] forty-four years of the plaintiff attaining the age of

26 twenty-one or within three years of the date the plaintiff  
27 discovers, or reasonably should have discovered, that the  
28 injury or illness was caused by childhood sexual abuse,  
29 whichever later occurs.

30 3. This section shall apply to any action arising on  
31 or after August 28, ~~2025~~ 2026.

32 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the  
33 contrary, a nondisclosure agreement by any party to a  
34 childhood sexual abuse action shall not be judicially  
35 enforceable in a dispute involving childhood sexual abuse  
36 allegations or claims, and shall be void."; and

37 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
