Amend SS/SCS/HCS/House Bill Nos. 2637 & 3155, Page 1, Section TITLE, Line 19,

2 by inserting after "session," the following: " and section
3 589.407 as truly agreed to and finally passed by house
4 committee substitute for senate bill no. 982, one hundred
5 third general assembly, second regular session"; and

6 Further amend said bill, page 2, section A, line 15, by
7 inserting after "session," the following: " and section
8 589.407 as truly agreed to and finally passed by house
9 committee substitute for senate bill no. 982, one hundred
10 third general assembly, second regular session"; and

11 Further amend said bill, page 185, section 589.405,
12 line 42, by inserting after all of said line the following:

13 "[589.407. 1. Any registration pursuant
14 to sections 589.400 to 589.425 shall consist of
15 completion of an offender registration form
16 developed by the Missouri state highway patrol
17 or other format approved by the Missouri state
18 highway patrol. Such form shall consist of a
19 statement, including the signature of the
20 offender, and shall include, but is not limited
21 to, the following:

22 (1) A statement in writing signed by the
23 person, giving the name, address, date of birth,
24 biological sex, as defined in section 191.1720,
25 Social Security number, and phone number of the
26 person, the license plate number and vehicle
27 description, including the year, make, model,
28 and color of each vehicle owned or operated by
29 the offender, any online identifiers[, as
30 defined in section 43.651,] used by the person,

31 the place of employment of such person,
32 enrollment within any institutions of higher
33 education, the crime which requires
34 registration, whether the person was sentenced
35 as a persistent or predatory offender pursuant
36 to section 566.125, the date, place, and a brief
37 description of such crime, the date and place of
38 the conviction or plea regarding such crime, the
39 age and gender of the victim at the time of the
40 offense and whether the person successfully
41 completed the Missouri sexual offender program
42 pursuant to section 589.040, if applicable;

43 (2) The fingerprints and palm prints of
44 the person;

45 (3) Unless the offender's appearance has
46 not changed significantly, a photograph of such
47 offender as follows:

48 (a) Quarterly if a tier III sex offender
49 [under section 589.414]. Such photograph shall
50 be taken every ninety days beginning in the
51 month of the person's birth;

52 (b) Semiannually if a tier II sex
53 offender. Such photograph shall be taken in the
54 month of the person's birth and six months
55 thereafter; and

56 (c) Yearly if a tier I sex offender. Such
57 photograph shall be taken in the month of the
58 person's birth; [and]

59 (4) A DNA sample from the individual, if a
60 sample has not already been obtained; and

61 (5) Information regarding any temporary
62 residence where the offender is staying away
63 from his or her primary residence for seven or
64 more days, including the period of time the
65 offender is staying in such place, regardless of
66 whether the temporary residence is in Missouri
67 or any other place.

68 2. The offender shall provide positive
69 identification and documentation to substantiate
70 the accuracy of the information completed on the
71 offender registration form, including but not
72 limited to the following:

73 (1) A photocopy of a valid driver's
74 license or nondriver's identification card;

75 (2) A document verifying proof of the
76 offender's residency; and

77 (3) A photocopy of the vehicle
78 registration for each of the offender's vehicles.

79 3. The Missouri state highway patrol shall
80 maintain all required registration information
81 in digitized form.

82 4. [Upon receipt of any changes to an
83 offender's registration information contained in
84 this section, the Missouri state highway patrol
85 shall immediately notify all other jurisdictions
86 in which the offender is either registered or
87 required to register.

88 5.] The offender shall be responsible for
89 reviewing his or her existing registration
90 information for accuracy at every regular in-
91 person appearance and, if any inaccuracies are
92 found, provide proof of the information in
93 question.

94 5. (1) Regular in-person appearances to
95 the registration official following initial
96 registration shall be required:

97 (a) Annually for tier I offenders;

98 (b) Every six months for tier II
99 offenders; and

100 (c) Every ninety days for tier III
101 offenders.

102 (2) For the purposes of establishing a
103 schedule for registration appearances, the
104 registration official shall ensure that the
105 required registration interval is followed from
106 the date of any initial registration until the
107 month of an offender's birth and at the
108 appropriate interval beginning from the month of
109 the offender's birth thereafter.

110 6. The signed offender registration form
111 shall serve as proof that the individual
112 understands his or her duty to register as a
113 sexual offender under sections 589.400 to

114 589.425 and a statement to this effect shall be
115 included on the form that the individual is
116 required to sign at each registration.

117 7. If an offender has a guardian appointed
118 by a court of competent jurisdiction, the
119 guardian may sign affirming the accuracy of the
120 offender registration form under this section.
121 Nothing in this subsection shall alleviate the
122 requirements of the offender to appear in
123 person, nor shall this subsection be construed
124 to affect any restrictions applicable to an
125 offender because of the offender's status on the
126 sexual offender registry.

127 8. Notwithstanding subsection 1 of section
128 527.270, no person required to register under
129 sections 589.400 to 589.425 shall change his or
130 her name for the period of time he or she is
131 required to be placed on the registry.]; and

132 Further amend said bill and page, section 589.407, line
133 10, by striking the words "defined in section 191.1720" and
134 inserting in lieu thereof the following: "designated on the
135 birth certificate".
