Amend SS/SCS/HCS/House Bill No. 1871, Page 1, Section A, Line 6,

2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "9.010. The first day of January, the third Monday of
4 January, the twelfth day of February, the third Monday in
5 February, the eighth day of May, the last Monday in May, the
6 nineteenth day of June, the fourth day of July, the first
7 Monday in September, the second Monday in October, the first
8 Tuesday after the first Monday in November of even-numbered
9 years, the eleventh day of November, the fourth Thursday in
10 November, and the twenty-fifth of December, are declared and
11 established public holidays; and when any of such holidays
12 falls upon Sunday, the Monday next following shall be
13 considered the holiday. There shall be no holiday for state
14 employees on the fourth Monday of October."; and

15 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
