### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Social Services - Division of Youth Services** indicate this proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE)** assume the proposal would result in no fiscal impact to their agency. DESE officials assume the proposal would allow school districts to establish youth at risk committees at the discretion of the of the district. Resources existing within the district would be used to support the committee, therefore the fiscal impact would be insignificant at the local level.

Officials from the **Kansas City**, **Missouri School District (KCMSD)** stated the KCMSD currently provides after school and summer programs for at risk youth.

Officials from the **Saint Louis Public Schools** assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their district.
