FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of the Governor** and **Office of Administration**, **Division of Budget and Planning** assumed, in response to similar proposals, this proposal would result in no fiscal impact to their organizations.

Officials from the office of the **Secretary of State** (SOS) stated that statewide newspaper publication of constitutional amendments cost approximately \$1,228 per column inch per publication date based on an estimate provided by the Missouri Press Service. The SOS estimated this proposal would require 10 column inches including title header and certification paragraph, for three required publications. (($$1228 \times 3 = $3,684$) x 10 = \$36,840).

Oversight assumes the referendum called for in this proposal would be held in November 2004.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business
