## FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri State Highway Patrol, Office of Prosecution Services** and the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** each assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Office of the Attorney General** assume any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services - Children's Division (CD)** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services - Family Support Division** assume this proposed legislation has no fiscal impact for the Family Support Division's child support program. The requirements of section 452.747.3, which pertain to the child support program, are found in current law at 452.455.4. This proposed legislation removes the provision currently found in subsection 452.455.3, which provides that when the noncustodial parent owes more than \$10,000, the custodial parent has the right to petition the court for the termination of parental rights.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services - Division of Legal Services (DLS)** assume DLS will be able to handle compliance with the legislation with existing resources. The legislation will require minor modification of some legal forms used by DLS, but these modifications can be handled with existing resources. DLS would defer to CD for an analysis of the fiscal impact of the legislation on CD.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
