**FISCAL ANALYSIS**

**ASSUMPTION**

**Oversight** notes due to time constraints the City of Farmington and the City of Perrysville were unable to respond to the changes made by the amendment to this proposal.

**§ 71.285 - City of Farmington Abatement of Nuisances Without Notification:**

*Senate Amendment 1*

**Oversight** assumes Senate Amendment 1 adds the City of Perrysville to the list of cities who may abate nuisances without notification and bill the property owner for the abatement.

**Oversight** assumes there is no measurable fiscal impact from this amendment on the City of Perrysville.

Officials at the **City of Farmington** assume this proposal will have no measurable fiscal impact on the City. The proposal reduces the direct labor and administrative expense related to enforcement of nuisance property ordinances. The only fiscal affect will be to improve the efficiency of police operations related to those offenses.

**Oversight** assumes the City of Farmington may recoup costs from the property owner if the city removes trash and weeds from a property with more than one violation within a calendar year.

**Oversight** assumes there is no measurable fiscal impact from this proposed legislation on the City of Farmington.
