FISCAL DESCRIPTION

Through the referendum process, a petition has been approved that has ordered an election on the enactment of Senate Substitute #2 for Senate Bill 19, to be held on November 6, 2018. Pursuant to Article III, Section 52(b) of the Missouri Constitution, this resolution moves the date of the election to August 7, 2018.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
