### FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety-Missouri State Highway Patrol**, **Department of Public Safety-Capitol Police**, **Department of Mental Health**, **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations**, **Office of State Courts Administrator**, and **Department of Social Services** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Springfield Police Department**, **Joplin Police Department**, **St. Louis County Police Department**, **Boone County Sheriff's Department**, and **St. Louis County Department of Justice** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

**Oversight** notes that the Department of Public Safety-Missouri State Highway Patrol, Department of Public Safety-Capitol Police, Department of Mental Health, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Office of State Courts Administrator, Department of Social Services, Springfield Police Department, Joplin Police Department, St. Louis County Police Department, Boone County Sheriff's Department, and St. Louis County Department of Justice have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local law enforcement were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
