§§70.441, 571.107, 577.703, and 577.712 - Concealed carry on public transportation systems

Oversight notes that the Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Highway Patrol, Department of Transportation, City of Columbia, City of Kansas City and Boone County Sheriff's Department have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations.
