ASSUMPTION

§§208.226 - 208.227 - Antipsychotic medications; MO HealthNet treatments/providers

Officials from the **Department of Mental Health** and the **Department of Social Services** (**DSS**) have each stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these organizations.

In response to a very similar proposal in 2019 (HB 867), **Oversight** contacted DSS officials for further clarification on their no impact response for this proposal. DSS officials stated MO HealthNet does not currently restrict any antipsychotic drugs and this proposal would place current practices into statute. Therefore, the provisions of this proposal will not have a fiscal impact on DSS or MO HealthNet.
