#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials at the **Department of Commerce and Insurance** and the **Missouri Department of Transportation** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

**Oversight** notes the Department of Commerce and Insurance and the Missouri Department of Transportation have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note for these agencies.

**Oversight** notes this proposal modifies the appointment qualifications for members of boards of public works in certain cities to include any resident of the county that receives services from such board. Oversight assumes this modification is codifying statute and will not have a direct fiscal impact on local governments.
