#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the Office of the State Courts Administrator (OSCA), the Department of Social Services and the Department of Health and Senior Services each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

**Oversight** notes according to OSCA's FY 2022 Budget Book, as of June 30, 2019, there are 13 family treatment courts serving 19 counties. These counties include Adair, Knox, Lewis, Jackson, Audrain, Pike, Callaway, Montgomery, Warren, St. Charles, St. Louis, Jefferson, St. Francois, Perry, Bollinger, Cape Girardeau, Scott, Mississippi, Dunklin, Greene and McDonald.
