FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§590.030 – Peace officer licensure

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources**, the **Department of Public Safety – (Capitol Police and Office of the Director)**, the **Department of Social Services**, the **Missouri Department of Conservation**, the **Kansas City Police Department**, and the **St. Louis County Police Department** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol (MHP)** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

In response to similar legislation from 2021 (HCS HB 839), the **MHP** stated there is no cost associated with law enforcement agency Rap Back Program enrollment, nor for law enforcement officer fingerprint submission.

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Crestwood Police Department**, the **St. Joseph Police Department**, and the **Walnut Grove Police Department** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other police and sheriff's departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
