Officials from the cities of **Brentwood**, **Kansas City**, **Norborne**, **O'Fallon**, **Southwest City**, **Springfield**, **St. Louis City** and **Tipton** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary.
