In response to similar legislation from this year (HCS for HB 519), officials from the cities of **Ballwin** and **O’Fallon** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

In response to similar legislation from this year (SB 306), officials from the cities of **Brentwood**, **Norborne**, **Southwest City** and **Tipton** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Bill as a Whole

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety**, the **Department of Natural Resources**, the **Attorney General’s Office**, the **Missouri Department of Conservation**, the **Missouri Department of Agriculture**, the **Department of Commerce and Insurance** and the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the **City of Claycomo**, the **City of Corder**, the **City of Hughesville**, the **City of Kansas City**, **St. Louis City** and the **City of Springfield** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
