ASSUMPTION

In response to similar legislation from this year (HCS for HB 519), officials from the cities of **Ballwin** and **O'Fallon** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

In response to similar legislation from this year (SB 306), officials from the cities of **Brentwood**, **Norborne**, **Southwest City** and **Tipton** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Bill as a Whole

Officials from the Department of Public Safety, the Department of Natural Resources, the Attorney General's Office, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Missouri Department of Agriculture, the Department of Commerce and Insurance and the Office of the State Courts Administrator each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the City of Claycomo, the City of Corder, the City of Hughesville, the City of Kansas City, St. Louis City and the City of Springfield each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
