ASSUMPTION

§188.207 – Prohibits expenditures of public funds for purposes relating to abortion, human cloning and prohibited human research

Officials from the **Office of Administration (OA) – Division of Purchasing (DP)** would have to include bid language to ensure medical services contracts are not awarded to such entities so that subsequent expenditures under the contract are not made to such entities for abortion services, human cloning, or prohibited human research, which would be minimal impact of less than \$5,000 for staff time.

Oversight has no information to the contrary but assumes the OA, DP has sufficient staff and resources available to absorb the minimal expenses incurred as a result of the provisions of this proposal and will present no fiscal impact for this agency for fiscal note purposes.

Officials from the **Attorney General’s Office, the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Economic Development, the Department of Higher Education and Workforce Development, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Revenue, the Department of Public Safety – Director’s Office, the Department of Social Services, the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules, the Missouri Department of Agriculture, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Office of Administration – Division of Budget and Planning, the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Office of the State Auditor, the Office of the Secretary of State, the Office of the State Public Defender, the City of Corder, the City of Kansas City, the City of O’Fallon, the City of Springfield, the Hermann Area Hospital District, Missouri State University, Northwest Missouri State University, State Technical College of Missouri and the University of Central Missouri** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the **Office of the State Treasurer** did not respond to **Oversight’s** request for a statement of fiscal impact.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities, various county officials, hospitals, and colleges and universities were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.




