FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE)** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. This proposal will likely have an impact on local school districts. DESE defers to them regarding the extent of any impact.

Officials from the Department of Higher Education and Workforce Development, St. Charles Community College, Missouri State University, Northwest State University, State Technical College of Missouri, and the University of Central Missouri each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **High Point R-III School District** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Officials from the **Springfield R-XII School District** assume the proposal could have an unknown fiscal impact on the district.

Oversight has requested additional information the Springfield School District, however, at the time of this fiscal note, no additional information has been received.

Based on the majority of the responses, **Oversight** does not anticipate a fiscal impact from this proposal. However, Oversight received limited responses from school districts related to the fiscal impact of this proposal. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information available. Upon the receipt of additional responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval to publish a new fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, school districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
