FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the cities of **Claycomo, Corder, Kansas City, O'Fallon, Springfield** and **St. Louis**, the **Ellisville Police Department**, the **Kansas City Police Department** and the **St. Louis County Police Department** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Oversight assumes there may be cities that charge permit fees for both the installation or use of a battery charged fence and/or an alarm system, however, Oversight is unaware of how many exist in the state and what fee is currently being charged for these permits. There is a potential that these cities who collect these permit fees would lose revenue from these fees, however, Oversight assumes these fees would be minimal. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities, counties, sheriff and police departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.




