FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Little Blue Valley Sewer District** assume a direct impact on their ability to issue bonds for expansion of their sewer plant. The sewer district is a very small portion of the county and a vote in the county to allow for additional debt could have an adverse outcome. Due to the growth of the County in the area they serve, they are in need of expanding their sewer treatment plant. In order to complete the expansion, they need to issue debt. This gives them the ability to go directly to their customers for approval.

Oversight assumes this proposal modifies the provisions for subdistricts which are part of a common sewer district in certain counties (Jackson and Cass) to issue bonds for the subdistrict. This proposal changes the percentage of voters required to assent from 4/7th or 3/4th of the customers of the subdistrict as defined in §204.370. Oversight assumes §204.569 is codifying statute to reflect the same percentage as §204.370 and will have no direct fiscal impact.

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State** and the **Joint Committee on Administrative Rules** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the **Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local election authorities, counties and sewer districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
