Officials from the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Social Services, the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, the Missouri Department of Conservation and the Missouri Department of Transportation each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** defer to the MoDOT/MSHP Medical Plan for its response regarding the potential fiscal impact of this proposal.
