#### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from **Kansas City** state this legislation imposes a 7.5% gross receipts tax on any public utility providing fiber networking who is not subject to franchise fees or gross receipts tax. This would result in a positive fiscal impact in an indeterminate amount.

Oversight assumes this legislations requires any public utility engaged in providing fiber networks to customers using fiber networks, built whole or in part in a political subdivision's right-of-way, who is not subject to franchise fees or gross receipts tax before August 28, 2021, shall pay to the political subdivision a gross receipts tax of 7.5% and shall not pay a linear foot fee. Oversight assumes this legislation could result in an unknown positive fiscal impact to local political subdivisions.

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance**, the **Department of Natural Resources**, the **Missouri Department of Transportation**, the **Office of Administration** and the **City of Corder** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other counties and cities were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.

## FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

A direct fiscal impact to a public utility engaged in providing fiber networks would be expected as a result of this proposal.

#### FISCAL DESCRIPTION

Under this act, any public utility engaged in providing fiber networks to customers using fiber networks, built whole or in part in a political subdivision's right-of-way, who is not subject to franchise fees or gross receipts tax before August 28, 2021, shall pay to the political subdivision a gross receipts tax of 7.5% and shall not pay a linear foot fee.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
