### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education**, **Department of Public Safety - Director's Office**, **Missouri Department of Transportation** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Missouri House of Representatives** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. The House will absorb any reasonable expenses of our members serving on the task force.

Officials from the **Missouri State Senate** anticipate a negative fiscal impact to reimburse 2 Senators for travel to task force meetings. The draft bill states the task force will meet three times per year, therefore, it will cost approximately \$673.38 per year.

**Oversight** assumes the responding agencies would not incur a material cost from the Task Force meetings and will not reflect a fiscal impact.
