FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office (AGO)** assume that any additional litigation costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing personnel and resources, however, the AGO may seek additional appropriations if there is a significant increase in litigation.

Oversight notes the AGO's response has changed from their response regarding similar legislation in prior years. In response to SB 336, the AGO assumed the need for 5 additional FTE (two FTE Assistant Attorneys General I and three FTE Consumer Service Operators). However, upon inquiry, the AGO verified that they believe the additional duties could be absorbed with current resources.

Officials from the **Department of Corrections**, the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Office of the State Public Defender** and **Office of the State Courts Administrator** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Missouri Office of Prosecution Services (MOPS)** assume no measurable fiscal impact to MOPS. The enactment of a new crime [407.1600.10] creates additional responsibilities for county prosecutors and the circuit attorney which may in turn result in additional costs which are difficult to determine.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.
