#### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Section 386.900 - Community Solar Pilot Program

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance - Missouri Public Service Commission (PSC)** state this legislation requires rulemaking by the PSC in order to implement the provisions. Rulemakings generally result in an estimated cost of up to approximately \$4,700.

The PSC also states that the PSC is funded by an assessment on Commission-regulated public utilities pursuant to Section 386.370, RSMo, and not by any state general appropriations. Depending on the cumulative effect of all PSC-impacting legislation passed in the current session and the associated increased costs associated with that legislation to the PSC, the PSC may need to request an increase in our appropriation authority and/or FTE allocation as appropriate through the budget process.

**Oversight** notes that the PSC has stated this individual proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact to PSC on the fiscal note.

Officials from the Office of Administration - Budget and Planning, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Missouri Department of Transportation and the Office of Administration each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.
