#### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from **Joint Committee on Public Employee Retirement (JCPER)** state this proposal has no direct fiscal impact to the Joint Committee on Public Employee Retirement. The JCPER's review of this legislation indicates it will not affect retirement plan benefits as defined in Section 105.660(9).

Officials from the **Public Schools and Education Employee Retirement Systems** state this proposed legislation makes a technical change to a provision of law relating to survivor benefits under the Public School Retirement System of Missouri in section 169.075, paragraph 4 and paragraph 6. As currently drafted this bill has no substantial fiscal or operational impact on PSRS or PEERS of Missouri.

**Oversight** notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.
