FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Section 376.1196 - Diagnostic Examinations for Breast Cancer Provisions

Officials from the **Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan (MCHCP)** state that MCHCP is not a health care plan under the definition of 376.1350, therefore this legislation would not apply to MCHCP. Section 104.801, requires MCHCP to follow any law which mandates coverage of specific health benefits, services of providers. Since this legislation is mandating cost share, they assume it does <u>not</u> apply to MCHCP.

However, if it did apply to MCHCP, MCHCP would estimate that it would have a fiscal impact. In 2020, their last year complete with claims, members spent \$145,449.34 on diagnostic mammograms. Due to 2020 being a year in which a lot of routine health care was pushed off due to the pandemic and health care trend, they estimate that MCHCP would have an impact of unknown but greater than \$150,000 if the bill would be deemed to apply to MCHCP.

This bill requires the coverage of both the PPO and High Deductible plans. Based on current IRS guidelines, paying for this service would put their high deductible plan at risk of not being a federally qualified plan. This would also put MCHCP at risk of not offering a federally qualified plan as required by statute.

Since it is unclear if this legislation applies to MCHCP, for fiscal note purposes, **Oversight** will reflect a \$0 (this legislation does not apply to MCHCP) to an unknown cost split between the General Revenue Fund, Federal Funds and Other Funds.

Oversight assumes this legislation could impact local government health insurance plans and will reflect a \$0 or Unknown cost to local political subdivisions.

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance**, the **Department of Social Services**, the **Missouri Department of Conservation**, the **Missouri Department of Transportation** and **Kansas City**, **O'Fallon** and **Springfield**, each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** defer to the Missouri Department of Transportation for the potential fiscal impact of this proposal.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A listing
