## FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

#### §162.481 – Independence School District School Board Terms and Elections

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** and **St. Louis County Board of Elections** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

In response to the previous version, officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State, Platte County Board of Elections**, and **St. Louis City Board of Elections** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other school districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. Upon the receipt of additional responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval to publish a new fiscal note. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.

#### Senate Amendment 1 (SA1)

**Oversight** notes SA 1 provides that a student enrolled in a school that receives state funds shall not be considered absent for the time such student spends attending a scheduled primary, general, or special election with his or her parent, legal guardian, or person standing in loco parentis to the student. A student may receive only one excused absence during each scheduled election.

Oversight assumes SA1 will have no fiscal impact on the underlying bill.
