DEFINITION:

This is a session-only position that performs professional ministerial duties for the Senate. Work includes providing a prayer to open each daily session and other related duties. Works under the general supervision of the Secretary of Senate.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provides ecumenical prayers at the opening of each daily session of the Senate.

Coordinates monthly Senate prayer breakfast.

Performs other ministerial duties as required.

ESSENTIAL KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES:

Ability to provide ministerial counseling and advising.

Ability to speak clearly and communicate effectively in a public forum.

Ability to apply religious principles in a work environment.

Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships.

TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:

Graduation from a recognized school of theology and be an ordained minister.
