FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials of the Missouri **Senate** and **House of Representatives**, in responses to similar proposals, stated the proposal would not affect those bodies.

Advertisement costs for the proposal would be \$4,380 per newspaper column inch for three publications of the text of the proposal, the introduction, title, fiscal note summary, and affidavit. The proposal would be on the ballot for the November 2000 general election.

This proposal would revise provisions concerning term limits of Missouri legislators to exclude partial terms of service when those partial terms are the first served in a chamber.
