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## FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Office of the State Public Defender** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

In response to similar legislation from last year, the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** and the **Department of Public Safety** assumed the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General** assume that the costs from this proposal for defending appeals from convictions is unknown but can be absorbed by their agency.

Officials from the **Office of Prosecution Services (OPS)** assumes that the costs from this proposal are unknown, but is assumed to be less than \$100,000

**Oversight** assumes that this proposal would not have a fiscal impact on the OPS.

## FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

Manufacturers, distributors, and sellers of firearms would likely be impacted by this proposal.

#### DESCRIPTION

This proposal prohibits manufacturers of concealable firearms or assault weapons, as defined in the act, from distributing such weapons unless they are equipped with a reusable child safety lock or firearm locking device.
